
Collect was conceived out of a long-time need to break ourselves out of the strict two-answer format of legacy SafetyNet checklists. Collect forms is designed as an addition to classic SafetyNet that allows for the intuitive and fluid creation and execution of jobsite documents that may require more input than just choosing a safe or unsafe.

Create, edit, & share templates

Authors may create and manipulate templates, which are reusable sets of questions that may be filled out and executed as a form. There are many different types of questions to choose from as you create your template. Questions can range from text boxes to choices, from singular to sections of related questions, and from simple input of information to more complex mathematical equations.

While creating your template, keep the end goal in mind: Overall, what do we want to answer here? Keep questions relevant and concise, and your templates logically easy to follow and understand.

Once created, you may go back and modify, delete, and share your templates. Users that templates are shared with may fill them out and view their completed forms.



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Our hope is that you find the freedom within Collect to create any document that you'll need for your workplace's needs. The functionality may be used over and over again and keeps templates and completed forms easily accessible at all times. Tired of surrendering to just "Yes" and "No"? Let's create something together!
