

Creating an Analyze Dashboard

Introduction

This short tutorial will show you how to create a dashboard.

1. To access SmartWork Analyze, click on 'SmartWork' menu, located in SafetyNet.

2. On the SmartWork landing page, click on 'Analyze'.



- 3. When you first enter Analyze, you will see the screen shown below. There will be some pre-made Dashboards available to you.
- 4. To create a new dashboard, select the + icon next to dashboards on the left-hand side and select '**New Dashboard**'.

5. A window will pop up to select the DataSet and name your dashboard. The dataset will default to 'PSC' unless a company-specific dataset(s) are available from our Collect module.



6. Once you have named your dashboard, click "create". From here you can begin adding Widgets.
