Home Dashboard Overview

1. The Dashboard provides an overview of Leading Safety Indicators (LSIs) that provide an at-a-glance summary of your key leading indicator performance over a specified time period. Information is displayed for performance at the organization level, regional or worksite level.



Dashboard Overview:
View overall performance for each leading indicator in summary view

Alerts:
Users are notified when a life threat or high severity at-risk condition/behavior is observed or when a user-defined goal is unmet.



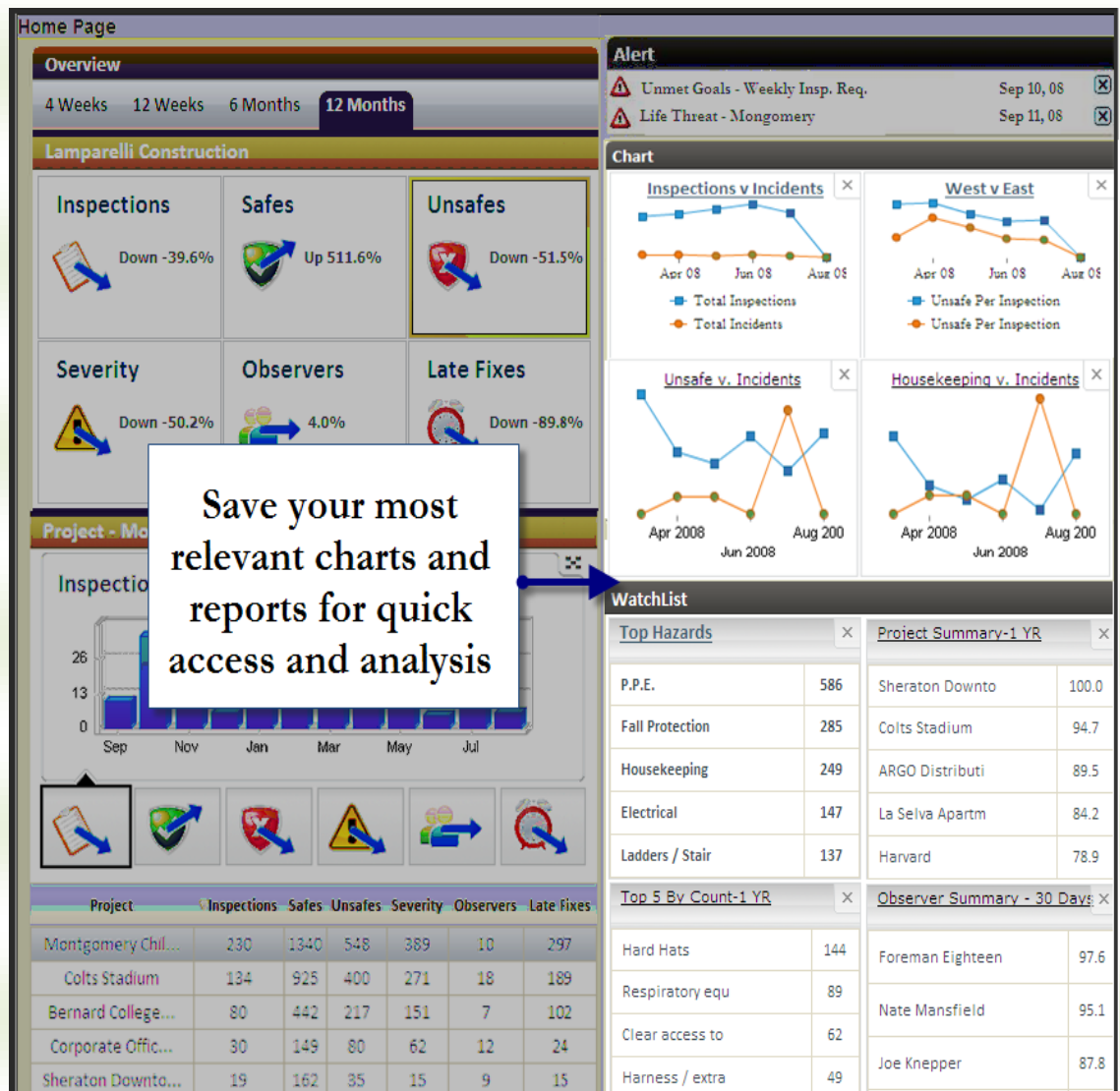

- b. My Charts – User selected graphs of critical information
 - i. Provide a quick, thumbnail picture of individual priorities, with one click access to a more detailed report for analysis
 - ii. Display data on critical metrics
 - iii. Identify and prioritize potential areas of risk


- c. My Watch Lists – User selected lists of critical information
 - i. Identify specific hazards, contractors, projects or inspectors to focus on
 - ii. Summarize key LSIs as defined by the user
 - iii. Identify and prioritize potential areas of risk
 - iv. Quickly gather positive feedback and focus attention on potential trouble spots



Home, Project And Contractor Dashboards

Project Dashboard Overview

- The Project Dashboard provides an overview of Leading Safety Indicators (LSIs) that provide an at-a-glance summary of your key leading indicator performance over a specified time period for a specific project.



Project Landing Page: Information is displayed for performance at the project level and the hazard, contractor, or observer levels.

Unsafe Observations Without Incident: Displays the number of unsafe observations collected since the last incident, and the avg # of unsafe obsvs between incidents for all projects in this company.

Scoreboard:

- Most Severe Observations:** Displays count for categories with the most medium, high and life-threat observations
- Most Unsafes:** Displays count for sub-categories with most unsafe observations
- Open Issue Closure Rate:** Displays the % of unsafe open issues resolved within 48 hrs.
- Distribution of Severity:** Displays the distribution of at-risk observations by severity level in pie chart format

Goals: Progress against customer-defined goals, e.g., *Number of Inspections* are tracked and displayed here.



Contractor Dashboard Overview

1. The Contractor Dashboard provides an overview of Leading Safety Indicators (LSIs) that provide an at-a-glance summary of your key leading indicator performance over a specified time period for a specific contractor.

View leading indicators for a specific contractor

Be alerted when user-defined goals for this contractor are met or remain unmet



View the distribution of at-risk observations for this contractor by severity level

Verify that the categories that are most frequently inspected make sense for a specific contractor.


Compare this contractor:

- To contractor peers in the same industry
- To all other contractors used by this customer

Compare leading indicators for this contractor 1) by project, 2) to those for another contractor used by this customer, 3) by inspectors who have observed the contractor, or 4) by category

Adding Charts

1. Select a specific report you would like to see from the Reports Menu.
 - a. *You can use the Comparison and Summary Reports*
2. Use the criteria section at the top to build your specific reporting needs.
3. Click on the Save Chart to Home Page.
 - a. *On the Summary Report this refers to the 2 Charts at the top of the Report*
4. Type in the name you remember it by and click OK.

- Creates link to Report


My Charts

6. Type in the name you remember it by and click OK


